

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"VEM DAMPER (PANEL TYPE)"

Based on the brochure and additional information submitted, i.e., video of installation instruction, subject article is a prefabricated, panel type, structural vibration damper. Visco-Elastic Material (VEM) Damper consists of a core plate (H-shape steel), and layers of steel plates and visco-elastic material laminated alternately. Subject article is to be bolted onto the steel columns of structures to lessen and dampen the vibrations in the building.



5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 73.08 of the 2012 ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) covers structures and parts of structures, of iron or steel; plates, rods, angles, shapes, sections, tubes and the like, prepared for use in structures, of iron or steel. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes state that the heading covers complete or incomplete metal structures, well as parts of structures. For the purpose of this heading, these structures are characterised by the fact that once they are put in position, they generally remain in that position. They are usually made up from bars, rods, tubes, angles, shapes, sections, sheets, plates, "wide flats" including so-called universal plates, hoop, strip, forgings or castings, by

In view thereof, subject article is classified under 2012 AHTN subheading 7308.90.20, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem, and Philippine-Japan Economic Partnership Agreement (PJEPA) and ASEAN-Japan Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (AJCEPA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "JP" or "AJ", respectively.

This ruling supersedes TCC No. 16-209, issued on 30 September 2016.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"SYNCROWAX HGLC-PA-(MH)"

Based on the safety data sheet, product catalog, product composition, certificate of analysis and sample submitted, subject article is a cosmetic grade synthetic wax containing a mixture of propane-1,2,3-triyl tridocosanoate and glycerides, C18-36. It is in the form of waxy solid with characteristic odour and has dropping point value of 71 °C. Imported in 125kg pails, it is used as structure builder, crystallinity modifier and emulsion stabiliser in different cosmetic products like lipsticks, balms, 2-in-1 creams and stick foundations, eye shadow, blusher and colour pencils, sunscreen sticks, deodorant sticks, and hair styling creams.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 34.04 of the 2012 ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) covers artificial waxes and prepared waxes. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (ENs) state this heading covers artificial waxes (sometimes known in industry as "synthetic axes") and prepared waxes, as defined in Note 5 to this Chapter, which consist of or contain relatively high molecular weight organic substances and which are not separate chemically defined compounds. These waxes are, among others, chemically produced organic products of a waxy character, whether or not water-soluble. Waxes of heading 27.12, produced synthetically or otherwise (e.g., Fischer-Tropsch waxes consisting essentially of hydrocarbons) are, however, excluded. Water-soluble waxy products having surface-active properties are also excluded (heading 34.02).

In view thereof, subject article is classified under 2012 AHTN subheading 3404.90.90 with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 1% ad valorem.

"PEPTAMEN®"

Based on the certificate of ingredients and sample submitted, subject article is a peptide-based formula composed of maltodextrin, whey protein, sucrose, triglycerides, potato starch, rapeseed oil, minerals, emulsifier, and vitamins, among others. Packed in 400 gram (net weight) cans, it is used as a complete peptide diet for people (10 years old onwards) who cannot digest or absorb nutrients from conventional food and people with fat malabsorption. It is suitable for use as sole source of nutrition or as a supplement via tube feeding or oral administration.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 21.06 of the 2012 ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) covers food preparations not elsewhere specified or included. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (ENs) state that provided that they are not covered by any heading of the Nomenclature, this heading covers, among others, preparations for use, either directly or after processing (such as cooking, dissolving or boiling in water, milk, etc.), for human consumption.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under 2012 AHTN subheading 2106.90.96, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 7% ad valorem.



Its conference codec enables the transmission and reception of voice, video and other data through connection to the Ethernet. received is displayed on the monitor for verbal communication and visual representations. primarily used in teleconferencing. Heading 85.17 of the 2012 ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) covers, among others, other apparatus for the transmission or reception of voice, images or other data, including apparatus for communication in a wired or wireless network (such as a local or wide area network), other than transmission or reception apparatus of heading 84.43, 85.25, 85.27 or 85.28. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (ENs) state that other communication apparatus includes apparatus which allows for the connection to a wired or wireless communication network or the transmission or reception of speech or other sounds, images or other data within such a network.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under 2012 AHTN subheading 8517.62.59, with Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of zero and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".
