DECREE OF ABANDONMENT

WHEREAS, a Memorandum dated May 20, 2019 was issued by the Customs Commissioner Rey Leonardo B. Guerrero, directing all District Collectors and all Sub-port Collectors to conduct examination of all abandoned shipments in order to ensure its immediate disposal;

WHEREAS, on 11 April 2022, pursuant to the foregoing Memorandum, Jayrald A. Savellano, Chief, Port Utilization Section, thru Crisostomo V. Mates, Jr. Chief, Piers and Inspection Division, this Port, requested for the issuance of a Decree of Abandonment against all Overstaying Cargoes located at the UTS Logistics and Distribution Co. Inc., with the following Container Numbers, Bill of Lading Numbers, and their respective consignees which arrived at this port on the following dates, to wit:

WHEREAS, on 30 May 2022, a Final Notice to claim Overstaying Cargoes was posted at the Bulletin Board and BOC website with the information that "Ten (10) days upon posting of the same at the BOC website the said cargoes will be declared abandoned by the District Collector and accordingly will be issued Decrees of Abandonment pursuant to the provisions of the CMTA";

WHEREAS, from the circumstances of the above-mentioned overstaying cargoes it can be safely presumed that the same have been abandoned by its owners pursuant to Section 1129 of the CMTA.

WHEREAS, Section 1129 (b) of the CMTA, provides, to wit:

"Section 1129. Abandonment, Kinds and Effects of. – Imported goods are deemed abandoned under any of the following circumstances;

- When the owner, importer, consignee, of the imported goods expressly signifies in writing to the District Collector the intention to abandon the same; or
- When the owner, importer, consignee, or interested party after due notice, fails to file the goods declaration within the prescribed period in Section 407 of this Act: *Provided*, That the term goods declaration shall include provisional or incomplete goods declaration deemed valid by the Bureau as provided in Section 403 of this Act. For this purpose, it is the duty of the District Collector, to post a list of all packages discharged and their consignees, whether electronically

or physically in the District Office, or send a notice to the consignee within five (5) days from the date of discharge; or

- c) Having filed such goods declaration, the owner, importer, consignee or interested party after due notice, fails to pay the assessed duties, taxes and other charges thereon, or, if the regulated goods failed to comply with Section 117 of this Act, within fifteen (15) days from the date of final assessment: Provided, That if such regulated goods are subject of an alert order and the assessed duties, taxes, and other charges thereof are not paid within fifteen (15) days from notification by the Bureau of the resolution of the alert order, the same also be deemed abandoned; or
- d) Having paid the assessed duties, taxes, and other charges, the owner, importer or consignee or interested party after due notice, fails to claim the goods within thirty (30) days from payment. For this purpose, the arrastre or warehouse operator shall report the unclaimed goods to the District Collector for disposition pursuant to the provisions of this Act; or
- e) xxxx;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, the above-mentioned cargoes listed in the Memorandum dated 11 April 2022 of Jayrald A. Savellano, Chief, Port Utilization Section, thru Crisostomo V. Mates, Jr. Chief, Piers and Inspection Division, are hereby declared **ABANDONED** in favor of the Government to be disposed of in the manner provided for by law.

Let copies of this Decree of Abandonment be furnished to all parties and offices concerned for their information and guidance.
