NOTICE OF OVERSTAYING CONTAINERS

Relative to the Disposition Form dated September 20, 2021, of Atty. Christian O. Flores, Chief, Customs Container Control Division (CCCD), recommended the issuance of Decrees of Abandonment for the above overstaying empty containers which failed to pay duties and taxes under Section 1129 of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA), let this be a Final Notice to Claim to all owners/shipping lines of the overstaying empty containers located Asian Terminals Inc. (ATI).

Ten (10) days upon posting of the same at the Bulletin Board and Bureau of Customs (BOC) website the said empty containers will be declared abandoned by the District Collector and accordingly will be issued Decree of Abandonment pursuant to the provisions of the CMTA.

DISCUSSIONS:

- 1. Pursuant to Executive Order (EO) 127, the Customs Container Control Division, POM (CCCD) is the office mandated to monitor all incoming and outgoing containers:
- 2. On the basis of the inventory provided for by the ATI, verified by the office of The Piers Inspection Division, there are fifty one (51) empty containers with more than 90 day dwell time owned by various shipping lines:
- 3. CAO 1-2015 and CAO 8-2019 provides that containers arriving, whether loaded or empty, shall be reexported within ninety (90) days from the date of discharge of the last package, otherwise, the containers shall be considered as importation, thus, subject to the payment of duties and taxes:
- 4. On June 15, 2021, District Collector Michael Angelo DC Vargas signed several demand letters that was sent through email to the respective shipping lines listed in the inventory with overstaying containers inside the ATI-CY, but this office inadvertently failed to print the demand letter for SITC for seven (7) overstaying containers, hence, we will submitting a separate Disposition Form thereof;
- 5. In a letter dated July 13, 2021, Mr. Richard Quiros, Operations Manager, Simba Logistics, signify their willingness to pay the customs of their overstaving containers taxes amounting to P14.149.49. (Annex "A");
- 6. Thus, on August 6, 2021, Simba Logistics paid the corresponding duties as evidenced by Customs Payment Receipt No. 0190916757;
- 7. Out of the ten (10) demand letters this Office sent, only Simba Logistics paid the duties and taxes;
- 8. Herewith is the list of empty containers owned and operated by various shipping lines which failed to comply with the letters of demand, to wit:
