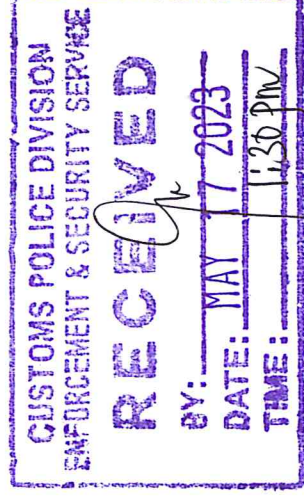

**6.3** During the Preliminary Conference the following shall be discussed:

- 6.3.1** Defining and simplifying the issues of the case;
- 6.3.2** Entering into admission or stipulation of facts;
- 6.3.3** Marking of exhibits;



- 6.3.4 The possibility of disposition of the goods pending forfeiture proceedings in case of perishable articles;

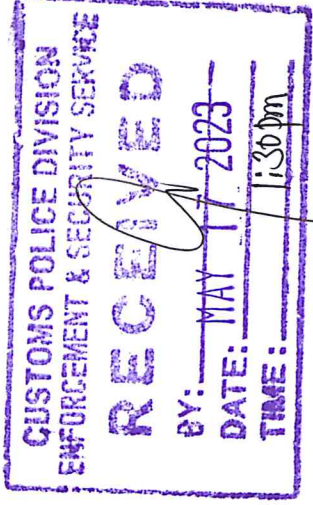

WHEREAS, on 12 April 2023, a shipment bound to San Jacinto, California, USA (Consignee: Mary Manalili) under House Airway Bill No. 771822931697 said to contain “LUXXE PAPAYA BODY SOAP, MEN’S BOXER SHORT, ASSORTED NATIVE BAG, ASSORTED PANTY FOR WOMEN, MINI DRESS FOR WOMEN, HOODIE JACKET FOR MEN, JUMPSUIT WITH BELT FOR WOMEN, DENIM SHORT FOR MEN, COTTON MATTRESS COVER, UNBRANDED MEN’S WALLET” under the name of GRACE BABAO with address at Tondo, Manila, PH (Contact No.: 3108098231) arrived at the Federal Express (FedEx) gateway facility and marked for verification/physical examination by the X-ray Inspector on duty;

WHEREAS, on 18 April 2023, Trade Control Examiner Julius Ceasar Asuncion conducted physical examination on the subject shipment in the presence of representative from FedEx with the following findings:


WHEREAS, on 05 May 2023, the Office of the District Collector received a Memorandum of even date from Ms. Maricar N. Go and Mr. Asuncion, Officer-In-Charge (OIC) Export Unit and Trade Control Examiner FedEx-Export, respectively, thru Atty. Lilibeth Sandag, Deputy Collector for Operations, recommending the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention (WSD) against the subject shipment based on the discrepancy between the goods found during the physical examination and goods declared in the commercial invoice for violation of Section 1113 paragraph (l) (3) and (4) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10863 otherwise known as the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA);

WHEREAS, upon evaluation thereof, this Office finds probable cause for the issuance of WSD against the subject shipment for violation of Section 1113 paragraphs (f) and (l) (3) and (4) of R.A. No. 10863 otherwise known as the CMTA;

**WHEREFORE**, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, and in compliance with pertinent Customs laws, rules and regulations, you are hereby ordered to forthwith seize the aforementioned articles and take custody over the same pending termination of the seizure and forfeiture proceedings and/or until further order from this Office. In this connection, please be guided by Customs Memorandum Order No. 8-84, particularly on the matter of making a return of service and submission of inventory of list of the subject articles.
