PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES FOR BUREAU OF CUSTOMS

This Addendum No. 1 dated 19 July 2023 is issued to clarify, modify or amend items in the Bid Documents. This shall form an integral part of the Bid Documents.

ISSUES Section I. Invitation to Bid

- 1. The Bureau of Customs (BOC) through the authorized appropriations under the CY 2023 General Appropriations Act intends to apply the sum of Ten Million Seven Hundred Fifty Two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Two Pesos and Sixty Seven Centavos (PhP10,752,752.67) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the "Provision of Security Services for Bureau of Customs" Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the bid opening.
- 2. The Bureau of Customs now invites bids for the above Procurement Project for the period of July 2023 to December 2023. Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address as indicated below on or before July 31, 2023, 9:30 a.m. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 9. Bid opening shall be on July 31, 2023, 10:00 a.m. at the given address below. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.



The deployment of guards may, from time to time, be changed as need arises, by the District Commander, ESS-Port of Manila/Port of MICP/Port of NAIA.

3) No guard shall be allowed or be required to render double or straight duty.
