

#### **DESCRIPTION OF GOOD**

#### "DXN TEA INFUSER"

Based on the product information sheet, production process flowcharts, and material test report submitted, subject article consists of a cylindrical stainless-steel infuser (strainer) and a clear glass canister with lid. The infuser has perforated sides (with tiny holes) and is used to hold loose tea leaves or teabag while being steeped in hot water inside the 200mL glass canister. Packed individually in kraft paper boxes, subject article has the following specifications:

#### **REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION**

Heading 73.23 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, table, kitchen or other household articles and parts thereof, of iron or steel. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers, among others, table, kitchen or other household articles and parts thereof. They may be fitted with lids, handles or other parts or accessories of other materials provided that they retain the character of iron or steel articles. The group includes articles for table use such as tea-strainers, among others.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 7323.93.10, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 15% ad valorem and the following applicable rates of duty under the various Philippine free trade agreements (FTA), subject to submission of the corresponding proof of origin:

#### 4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

#### "UNITED D3"

Based on the product composition, technical data sheet, Certificate of Product Registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), manufacturing process flowchart, product label, and photograph of the packaging submitted, subject article is pure feed-grade cholecalciferol (vitamin D<sub>3</sub>) in a matrix of gelatin and carbohydrates and stabilized with anti-oxidant butylated hydroxytoluene (BHT), in the form of white to almost-white crystalline particles. Packed in 10-kg, 15-kg, 20-kg, and 25-kg drums, subject article is added to swine and poultry feeds at a rate of 1 to 5 g per kilogram of feeds, as a vitamin supplement to prevent vitamin D<sub>3</sub> deficiency in animals.

#### 5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 29.36 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers provitamins and vitamins, natural or reproduced by synthesis (including natural concentrates), derivatives thereof used primarily as vitamins, and intermixtures of the foregoing, whether or not in any solvent. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that vitamins are active agents, usually of complex chemical composition, which are obtained from outside sources and are essential for the proper functioning of human or other animal organisms. They cannot be synthesised by the human body and must therefore be obtained in final or nearly final form (provitamins) from outside sources. They are effective in relatively minute amounts and may be regarded as exogenous biocatalysts, their absence or deficiency giving rise to metabolic disturbances or "deficiency diseases". This heading includes vitamin D<sub>3</sub> and derivatives thereof with similar activity. Vitamin D<sub>3</sub> or activated or irradiated 7-dehydrocholesterol (cholecalciferol). White crystalline powder. It deteriorates slowly when exposed to air; insoluble in water, soluble in fats. It can be extracted from fish oil and from fish liver oil, but is generally obtained by activating or irradiating provitamin D<sub>3</sub>. It has a stronger activity than vitamin D<sub>2</sub>.

Furthermore, the products of this heading may be stabilised for the purposes of preservation or transport such as by adding anti-oxidants, by adding anti-caking agents(e.g., carbohydrates), by coating with appropriate substance (e.g., gelatin, waxes or fats), whether or not plasticized, or by adsorbing on appropriate substances (e.g., silicic acid), provided that the quantity added or the processing in no case exceeds that necessary for their preservation or transport and that the addition or processing does not alter the character of the basic product and render it particularly suitable for specific use rather than for general use.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 2936.29.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of zero; ASEAN-China Free Trade Area (ACFTA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "E"; and Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) Agreement rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "RCEP" or Declaration of Origin (DO) issued by an Approved Exporter.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

#### 4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

#### "CATAFLAM® (DICLOFENAC POTASSIUM) 25 mg"

Based on the prescribing information and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is a sugar-coated tablet containing 25 mg of diclofenac potassium (active ingredient) and excipients. Diclofenac potassium is a non-steroidal compound with pronounced antirheumatic, analgesic, anti-inflammatory, and antipyretic properties. It is indicated for the short-term treatment of post-traumatic and post-operative pain, inflammation, and swelling; migraine attacks; painful syndromes of the vertebral column; and non-articular rheumatism, among others. Packed in boxes containing 100 tablets (10 pieces of 10-tablet blister packs), subject article is to be taken whole with liquids, preferably before meals, as prescribed by a healthcare professional.



#### 5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Note 2 to Section VI of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 states that goods classifiable in heading 30.04, 30.05, 30.06, 32.12, 33.03, 33.04, 33.05, 33.06, 33.07, 35.06, 37.07 or 38.08 by reason of being put up in measured doses or for retail sale are to be classified in those headings and in no other heading of the Nomenclature.

Heading 30.04 of the AHTN 2022 covers medicaments (excluding goods of heading 30.02, 30.05 or 30.06) consisting of mixed or unmixed products for therapeutic or prophylactic uses, put up in measured doses (including those in the form of transdermal administration systems) or in forms or packings for retail sale. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers medicaments consisting of mixed or unmixed products, provided they are, among others, put up in measured doses or in forms such as tablets, ampoules (for example, re-distilled water, in ampoules of 1.25 to 10 cm³, for use either for the direct treatment of certain diseases, e.g., alcoholism, diabetic coma or as a solvent for the preparation of injectible medicinal solutions), capsules, cachets, drops or pastilles, medicaments in the form of transdermal administration systems, or small quantities of powder, ready for taking as single doses for therapeutic or prophylactic use.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3004.90.53, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 5% ad valorem.

#### 4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

#### "VOLTAREN® SR (DICLOFENAC SODIUM) 100 mg"

Based on the prescribing information and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is a sustained-release, film-coated tablet containing 100 mg of diclofenac sodium (active ingredient) and excipients. Diclofenac sodium is a non-steroidal compound with pronounced antirheumatic, anti-inflammatory, analgesic, and antipyretic properties. It is indicated for the treatment of inflammatory and degenerative forms of rheumatism; post-traumatic and post-operative pain, inflammation, and swelling; and painful and/or inflammatory conditions in gynecology. Packed in boxes containing 100 tablets (10 pieces of 10-tablet blister packs), subject article is to be taken whole with liquids, preferably before meals, as prescribed by a healthcare professional.



#### 5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Note 2 to Section VI of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 states that goods classifiable in heading 30.04, 30.05, 30.06, 32.12, 33.03, 33.04, 33.05, 33.06, 33.07, 35.06, 37.07 or 38.08 by reason of being put up in measured doses or for retail sale are to be classified in those headings and in no other heading of the Nomenclature.

Heading 30.04 of the AHTN 2022 covers medicaments (excluding goods of heading 30.02, 30.05 or 30.06) consisting of mixed or unmixed products for therapeutic or prophylactic uses, put up in measured doses (including those in the form of transdermal administration systems) or in forms or packings for retail sale. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers medicaments consisting of mixed or unmixed products, provided they are, among others, put up in measured doses or in forms such as tablets, ampoules (for example, re-distilled water, in ampoules of 1.25 to 10 cm³, for use either for the direct treatment of certain diseases, e.g., alcoholism, diabetic coma or as a solvent for the preparation of injectible medicinal solutions), capsules, cachets, drops or pastilles, medicaments in the form of transdermal administration systems, or small quantities of powder, ready for taking as single doses for therapeutic or prophylactic use.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3004.90.53, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 5% ad valorem.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
