RETURNING TO VENDOR

Attached is a letter-reply to Ms. Raquel D. Bayot dated 07 February 2024 with IIS Transaction No. CO-2024-004788 inquiring about the requirements in the exportation of off-specs chemical identified as Butyl Cellosolve (Ethylene glycol monobutyl ether) with a quantity of fifteen (15) kilograms to Japan for the purpose of returning the same to the vendor.

Acting on the request, EMB-DENR **interposed no objection** to the proposed export without need of Export Clearance subject to the following conditions that:

- a. it shall be limited to the declared type and quantity of material; and
- b. it does not preclude compliance with the requirements of other government agencies having mandates or jurisdiction regulating the same, as well as with the domestic regulation of the country of import.
