SUBJECT : REGULATION ON THE EXPORT OF NOT MORE THAN 50
KILOGRAMS OF MELTED SILVER BY UNISILVER GROUP
INTERNATIONAL CORPORATION

This has reference to the letter dated 25 January 2024 from Mr. Edgardo D. Castillo, Chief, Mine Management Division and Officer-in-Charge, Regional Director in Concurrent Capacity, Mines and Geosciences Bureau, Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), on the abovementioned subject.

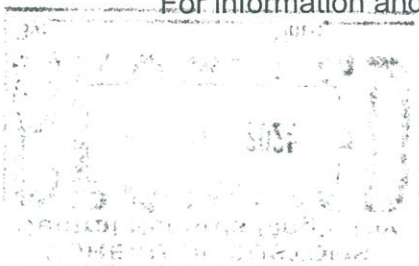
The DENR informed the Bureau of Customs that a certification for exportation and transportation, i.e., Ore Transport Certification, Ore Transport Permit, or Mineral Ore Export Permit, is not necessary for the transport of the subject materials, in view of the following:

- a. Ore Transport Permit/Mineral Ore Export Permit is only issued to Permit Holders; Contractors; Accredited Traders/Retailers/Processors and Patent Holders; and
- b. Based on the assessment of the DENR, the finished products, i.e., pieces of jewelry, were exported to the Philippines from India through Malaysia. The damaged materials were then melted to eliminate the impurities, prior to return to the source country.

The DENR also advised that the above references serve as a Certification and are valid with no expiration.

For records purposes, please confirm the dissemination of this circular throughout your offices within fifteen (15) days from receipt hereof.

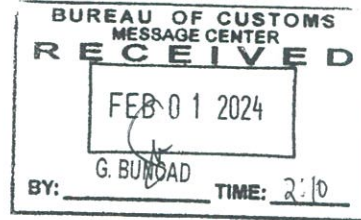

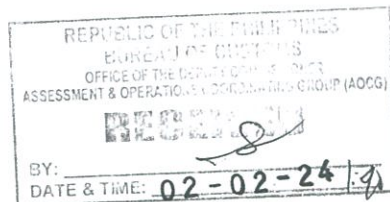
