In line with the policy of the Bureau of Customs to streamline customs processes to make cargo clearance formalities predictable, transparent, and trade facilitative, the Bureau's official signatories on the Examination Report after the conduct of regular examination at the Designated Examination Area are the following, to wit:

1. Assigned Customs Examiner;
2. Authorized Representative- Customs Intelligence and Investigation Service;
3. Authorized Representative- Enforcement and Security Service
4. Authorized Representative-Xray-Inspection Project (for shipments subject to non-intrusive inspection only)

Customs personnel performing border control functions assigned at the DEA who are not signatories shall witness the conduct of examination to ensure that only legitimate shipments are facilitated by the Bureau of Customs.
