INDUSTRIES, INC. (FPI) RELATIVE TO ALLEGED CHINA
TRADE DATA DISCREPANCY PERTAINING TO POLYMER OF
VINYL CHLORIDE (PVC) RESIN FROM 2020 TO 2023

In the letter transmitted by the Federation of Philippine Industries, Inc. (FPI) thru the Department of Finance (DOF) dated 27 February 2024, hereto attached as Annex "A", it was alleged that the China export statistics are higher than the import data of the Philippines from 2020 to 2023 for **Polymer of Vinyl Chloride (PVC) resin** under the Harmonized System (HS) codes 39041090 for China, and 39041010, 39041091, 39041092 and 39041099 for Philippines.

Hence, in view of the foregoing, all collection districts are hereby directed to exercise vigilance and observe proper valuation on all importations of PVC resin to combat illicit trade practices as well as ensure lawful collection of duties and taxes.
