4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"HIGH DHA LC-PUFAs TYPE NIF (28 kg)"

Based on the certificate of composition, certificate of analysis, purchasing specifications, manufacturing process flowchart, supplemental information, and packaging information submitted, subject article is a fish oil with d-delta rich tocopherols (antioxidant), in the form of a clear, yellowish, oily liquid. The oil is extracted from the heads of different tuna species such as *Thunnus albacares*, *Thunnus alalunga*, *Thunnus obesus*, and *Katsuwonus pelamis*. Packed in 28-kg drums (net weight), subject article is used as an ingredient in the manufacture of spraydried milk, as a source of docosahexaenoic acid (DHA).

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 15.04 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers fats and oils and their fractions, of fish or marine mammals, whether or not refined, but not chemically modified. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers fats and oils and their fractions, derived from several varieties of fish (cod, halibut, menhaden, herring, sardines, anchovy, pilchard, etc.) or marine mammals (whales, dolphins, seals, etc.). They are extracted from the body or liver of the fish or marine mammal or from waste thereof. They usually have a characteristic fishy smell and a disagreeable taste, and vary in colour from yellow to reddish-brown.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 1504.20.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem and Philippines-European Free Trade Association Free Trade Agreement (PH-EFTA FTA) rate of duty of zero for Switzerland, subject to submission of an Origin Declaration.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

"LC-PUFA MIX TYPE SAS 44 (28 kg)"

Based on the certificate of composition, certificate of analysis, raw material purchasing specifications, manufacturing process flowchart, and packaging information submitted, subject article is a clear, yellowish, oily liquid. It is composed of a mixture of high oleic sunflower oil (Helianthus annuus L.), algal oil extracted from the biomass of Schizochytrium sp. (T18), and fungal oil extracted from the biomass of Mortierella alpina (149-N18), with antioxidants (concentrates of natural mixed tocopherols and L-ascorbyl palmitate). The fungal oil was standardized with high oleic sunflower oil to obtain 40% arachidonic acid (ARA). Packed in 28-kg drums (net weight), subject article is used as an ingredient in the manufacture of spray-dried milk, as a source of docosahexaenoic acid (DHA) and arachidonic acid (ARA).

REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 15.17 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, edible mixtures or preparations of animal, vegetable or microbial fats or oils or of fractions of different fats or oils of this Chapter, other than edible fats and oils or their fractions of heading 15,16. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that they are generally liquid or solid mixtures or preparations of, among others, two or more of animal, vegetable or microbial fats or oils or their fractions.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 1517.90.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 15% ad valorem and Philippines-European Free Trade Association Free Trade Agreement (PH-EFTA FTA) rate of duty of zero for Switzerland, subject to submission of an Origin Declaration.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.



4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"OIL MIX LC-PUFA TYPE ADS (28 kg)"

Based on the certificate of composition, certificate of analysis, raw material purchasing specifications, manufacturing process flowchart, and packaging information submitted, subject article is a clear, yellowish, oily liquid. It is composed of a mixture of high oleic sunflower oil (Helianthus annuus L.), fish tuna oil (Thunnus albacares, Thunnus alalunga, Thunnus obesus and Katsuwonus pelamis) rich in high docosahexaenoic acid (DHA), fungal oil rich in arachidonic acid (ARA) extracted from the biomass of Mortierella alpina (ATCC 32222), and sunflower oil (Helianthus annus L.), with antioxidants (concentrates of natural mixed tocopherols and L-ascorbyl palmitate). The fungal oil was standardized with high oleic sunflower oil to obtain 40% ARA, while the sunflower oil is added to adjust the value of linoleic acid. Packed in 28-kg drums (net weight), subject article is used as an ingredient in the manufacture of spray-dried milk, as a source of DHA and ARA.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 15.17 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, edible mixtures or preparations of animal, vegetable or microbial fats or oils or of fractions of different fats or oils of this Chapter, other than edible fats and oils or their fractions of heading 15.16. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that they are generally liquid or solid mixtures or preparations of, among others, two or more of animal, vegetable or microbial fats or oils or their fractions.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 1517.90.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 15% ad valorem and Philippines-European Free Trade Association Free Trade Agreement (PH-EFTA FTA) rate of duty of zero for Switzerland, subject to submission of an Origin Declaration.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"ELITE™ 5401GT ENHANCED POLYETHYLENE RESIN"

Based on the technical specifications, safety data sheet, packaging information, and the declared formulation submitted, subject article is an ethylene-octene copolymer resin, containing by weight less than 94% ethylene and more than 6% 1-octene, with slip and anti-block additives. It is in the form of translucent to white pellets, with a melt flow index of 1.0 g/10 minutes and a density of 0.917 g/cm³. Packed in 25-kg heavy duty bags, subject article is used in the manufacture of food and specialty packaging films, and very tough thin-gauge films.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Note 4 to Chapter 39 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 states that the expression "copolymers" covers all polymers in which no single monomer unit contributes 95 % or more by weight to the total polymer content. For the purposes of this Chapter, except where the context otherwise requires, copolymers (including co-polycondensates, co-polyaddition products, block copolymers and graft copolymers) and polymer blends are to be classified in the heading covering polymers of that comonomer unit which predominates by weight over every other single comonomer unit.

Furthermore, Note 6 (b) to this Chapter states that in headings 39.01 to 39.14, the expression "primary forms" applies only to blocks of irregular shape, lumps, powders (including moulding powders), granules, flakes and similar bulk forms.

Heading 39.01 of the AHTN 2022 covers polymers of ethylene, in primary forms.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3901.40.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem and the following applicable rates of duty under the various Philippine free trade agreements (FTA), subject to submission of the corresponding proof of origin:



"MC-11 MASPION PLASTIC WALL CABINET-FIRST AID BOX"

Based on the brochure, technical specifications, product composition and use, manufacturing process, and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is a white cabinet-type first aid box made primarily of high impact polystyrene (HIPS) material. Its hinged door has a transparent polystyrene sheet to easily see the contents of the box, and a magnetic door catch for easy opening and closing. Having an overall dimension (W x H x D) of 31 cm x 44 cm x 11.4 cm, subject article is designed to be mounted on the wall.



REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 94.03 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers other furniture and parts thereof. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers furniture and parts thereof, not covered by the previous headings. It includes furniture for general use (e.g., cupboards, show-cases, tables, telephone stands, writingdesks, escritoires, book-cases, and other shelved furniture (including single shelves presented with supports for fixing them to the wall), etc.), and also furniture for special uses.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 9403.70.90. with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 15% ad valorem and the following applicable rates of duty under the various Philippine free trade agreements (FTA), subject to submission of the corresponding proof of origin:
