AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES

Relative to the abovementioned subject, all importations of plant-based agricultural commodities, regardless of the categories they fall under, are hereby directed to go through the BPI – Plant Quarantine Office at the respective ports for the mandatory document verification and inspection.

This procedure follows the provisions stated in the DA Department Circular No. 4, series of 2016, with the subject: "Guidelines on the Importation of Plants, Planting Materials, and Plant Products of Commercial Purposes."

First of all, we would like to extend our gratitude for your continuous assistance and support for the implementation of plant quarantine and food safety mandate of this office at the border.


