### 4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

### "AVIZANT® YELLOW 20 HS"

Based on the product and safety data sheets, Veterinary Drug and Product Declaration Form and Certificate of Feed Product Registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), manufacturing process, and product label submitted, subject article is a yellowish to rose-coloured, free-flowing powder containing natural xanthophyll (yellow pigment) obtained from the saponified extract of marigold (*Tagetes erecta*) flowers. It also contains wheat middling and calcium carbonate. Packed in 25-kg semi-vacuum sealed aluminium/polyethylene bags, subject article is to be mixed with poultry feeds to add color to food obtained from poultry (e.g., egg yolk, broiler skin, and fat).

### 5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 32.03 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, colouring matter of vegetable or animal origin (including dyeing extracts but excluding animal black), whether or not chemically defined. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers the greater part of the products of vegetable or animal origin used mainly as colouring substances. These products are generally extracted from materials of vegetable origin (wood, barks, roots, seeds, flowers, lichens, etc.) or of animal origin, by steeping them in water or in weak acid or ammonia solution or, in the case of certain vegetable materials, by fermentation. They are included in this heading whether or not they are chemically defined compounds. The heading includes colouring matter and dyeing extracts of vegetable origin obtained from logwood (haematein, haematoxylin, etc.), yellow woods (fustic, Cuba and Tampico woods, etc.), red woods (Pernambuco, Lima, Brazil wood, etc.), sandalwood, quercitron wood, black cutch (acacia catechu), annatto, madder, alkenna, henna, turmeric, Persian berries, safflower, saffron, etc. The heading also includes chlorophyll extracted from nettles and from various other plants, as well as sodium-chlorophyll, copper-chlorophyll and xanthophyll. The heading also covers preparations based on colouring matter of vegetable or animal origin, of a kind used for colouring any material or used as ingredients in the manufacture of colouring preparations.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3203.00.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
