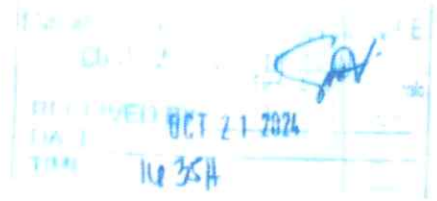

WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION

To **ESS-CPD**
Sector Commander
Sub-Port of General Santos

WHEREAS, on 06 October 2024, 2nd South Cotabato Provincial Mobile Force Company, together with Sto. Niño Municipal Police Station, CIDG South Cotabato, Highway Patrol, SCPIU, RID 12, and RSOG, while conducting a joint checkpoint operation at Barangay Panay, Sto. Niño, South Cotabato, were able to stop a vehicle loaded with smuggled cigarettes which resulted to its seizure, to wit:

WHEREAS, on 07 October 2024, the above-seized articles were turned over by Police Major Raymon L. Faba, through PMSg. June Estiaga, from Sto. Niño Municipal Police Station, South Cotabato, and received by SAI Rogel E. Julio, Sector Commander, ESS-CPD, Sub-Port of General Santos, for safekeeping and for purposes of proper disposition;

WHEREAS, on 07 October 2024, Customs Examiner Vivian A. Jimenez, submitted a report, relative to the conduct of physical examination of the seized items. Customs Examiner Jimenez issued a certification that the seized goods were considered as smuggled and recommended for the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention in violation of Section 117, Section 1113 and Section 400 of R.A. No. 10863 otherwise known as the "Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA)";

WHEREAS, on 08 October 2024, ESS District Commander SP/LT. Mangurun C. Batuampar, Jr., and CIIS Chief IO-II Felix A. Espino III, also recommended for the issuance of Warrant of Seizure and Detention; and

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested by law in this Office, you are hereby ordered to forthwith SEIZE the aforementioned articles and take into physical possession and, custody thereof. Compliance with Customs Administrative Order No.10-2020, particularly, in the manner of making a return of service is likewise prescribed and the submission of inventory Report on the list of the seized cargo is to be strictly observed.
