This has reference to the electronic mail received by this Office on 14 November 2024 from Mr. Robert John Tan, Information Systems Analyst III, Department of Finance (DOF), Central Management Information Office, informing that the Collaborative Partner Agreement (CPA) for our Philippines ASW (ASEAN Single Window) Gateway System with Vietnam has been successfully uploaded. As a result, the electronic exchange of both the electronic Certificate of Origin (eCO) and the ASEAN Customs Declaration Document (ACDD) with Vietnam is now fully operational.

Hence, stakeholders processing eCO and ACDD electronically with Vietnam may now proceed with their application. Those applying for the electronic Certificate of Origin (eCO) can now submit their applications through the ASW Gateway, as the system is fully operational for these exchanges.
