WHEREAS, on 04 November 2024, Kiamba Police Station, together with 2nd SPMFC, SPPO PIU and MLET Kiamba conducted checkpoint operation along Brgy. Katubao, Kiamba, Sarangani Province. During the operation, they were able to flag down a vehicle loaded with smuggled cigarettes which resulted to its seizure, to wit:
