The Bureau of Customs takes pride in upholding its core values of **Professionalism**, **Excellence**, **Integrity**, **and Accountability** as guiding principles in all its operations and communications. In line with these values and pursuant to **Executive Order** ("EO") **No. 463**, **Series of 1998**, this Office wishes to highlight the importance of consistency in the use of the official designations of certain units within the Bureau.

1. As stated in Section 1¹ of EO No. 463, S. 1998, the <u>Management Information Systems and Technology Group</u> ("MISTG") was formally established as a new office in the Bureau of Customs, tasked with overseeing the Bureau's information systems and technology infrastructure. The name itself reflects the comprehensive scope of its mandate, as the term <u>"Systems"</u> emphasizes its multifaceted nature.

[&]quot;A new office in the Bureau of Customs is hereby created and shall be known as the Management Information Systems and Technology Group (hereinafter referred to as MISTG for brevity)."

- It has come to this Office's attention that some communications, documents, and memoranda have varied in their reference to the MISTG, omitting the plural <u>"S"</u> in <u>"Systems"</u> in certain instances.
- 3. In addition to MISTG, the inclusion of <u>"Systems"</u> in the official designations of the Planning and <u>Systems</u> <u>Development Service</u> ("PSDS") and the <u>Systems</u> <u>Management Division</u> ("SMD") under the <u>Technology Management Service</u> ("TMS") accurately reflects the breadth and complexity of the functions these offices/units perform. The plural <u>"Systems"</u> in PSDS highlights its expansive role in the development and management of multiple systems, while the <u>"Systems"</u> in SMD underscores the comprehensive scope of the division's responsibilities in managing various technological systems. Omitting the plural would fail to capture the full scope of these units' mandates.
- While this may seem minor, consistent use of official designations is essential for maintaining precision and professionalism in the Bureau's records and correspondences.
- 5. This memorandum serves to affirm the official nomenclature as outlined in the enabling Executive Order. The <u>Management Information Systems and Technology Group</u>, including its offices/units such as the <u>Planning and Systems Development Service</u> and the <u>Systems Management Division under the Technology Management Service</u>, are integral to the Bureau's structure, and their proper designations reflect the professionalism and rigor that define our work.
- 6. This acknowledgment of nomenclature ensures that communications within the Bureau and with external stakeholders remain aligned with our commitment to accuracy, clarity, and excellence.
