ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 02-2024 ON THE ANNUAL
SUPERVISION CHARGE FOR CUSTOMS COMMON BONDED
WAREHOUSES AND ITS ACCREDITED MEMBERS

This is to reiterate the implementation of Customs Administrative Order (CAO) No. 02-2024 entitled "*Customs Dues, Fees and Charges*", regarding Section 5.31 on the Annual Supervision Charge (formerly Annual Supervision Fee) for Customs Bonded Warehouses (CBWs).

As provided under Section 5.31.3 of the same CAO, an annual supervision charge shall be paid by the CBW Operator based on the following schedule:

Operator of CCBW	Php250,000.00
Every accredited member of CCBW	
Total Assets in Peso (excluding real estate)	Rate
Php3 million and below	Exempted
Above Php3 million but not more than Php15 million	Php25,000.00
Above Php15 million but not more than Php50 million	Php50,000.00
Above Php50 million	Php100,000.00
For every extension warehouse	
Operator of CCBW and its accredited member	Php50,000.00
