4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"ABIRATERONE ACETATE (ABIRATRED) 250 mg FILM-COATED TABLET 120's"

Based on the Certificate of Product Registration from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), package insert, and safety data sheet submitted, subject article is an antineoplastic (hormone antagonist) drug in the form of a white to off-white, oval-shaped, film-coated tablet containing 250 mg of abiraterone acetate. Abiraterone acetate is converted *in vivo* to abiraterone, an androgen biosynthesis inhibitor. Specifically, abiraterone selectively inhibits the enzyme 17α-hydroxylase/C17,20-lyase (CYP17). This enzyme is expressed in and is required for androgen biosynthesis in testicular, adrenal, and prostatic tumour tissues. Packed in white plastic bottles containing 120 tablets, subject article is indicated with prednisone or prednisolone for the treatment of metastatic castration resistant prostate cancer in adult men who are asymptomatic or mildly symptomatic after failure of androgen deprivation therapy in whom chemotherapy is not yet clinically indicated, or in adult men whose disease has progressed on or after a docetaxel-based chemotherapy regimen.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 30.04 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers medicaments (excluding goods of heading 30.02, 30.05 or 30.06) consisting of mixed or unmixed products for therapeutic or prophylactic uses, put up in measured doses (including those in the form of transdermal administration systems) or in forms or packings for retail sale. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers medicaments consisting of mixed or unmixed products, provided they are, among others, put up in measured doses or in forms such as tablets, ampoules (for example, redistilled water, in ampoules of 1.25 to 10 cm³, for use either for the direct treatment of certain diseases, e.g., alcoholism, diabetic coma or as a solvent for the preparation of injectible medicinal solutions), capsules, cachets, drops or pastilles, medicaments in the form of transdermal administration systems, or small quantities of powder, ready for taking as single doses for therapeutic or prophylactic use.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 3004.39.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 1% ad valorem and ASEAN-India Free Trade Area (AIFTA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "AI".

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"ALUMINUM COMPOSITE PANEL, MODEL: WORLDBOND"

Based on the brochure, technical specifications, and sample submitted, subject article is a composite panel consisting of a polyethylene core sandwiched between chromate-treated aluminium alloy plates. The upper aluminium layer is coated with a primer, polyvinylidene fluoride (PVDF)/polyester (PE) top paint (available in many colours), PVDF clear coating, and protective film, while the lower aluminium layer is generally coated with service coating or mill finish. Designed for use as, among others, building cladding material and decorative elements for exterior and interior building use, subject article has the following specifications:

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 76.10 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers, among others, aluminium plates, rods, profiles, tubes and the like, prepared for use in structures. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that the provisions of the Explanatory Note to heading 73.08 apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to this heading. In the case of aluminium, structural parts are sometimes bonded together with synthetic resins or rubber compounds instead of being fixed by the ordinary methods of riveting, bolting, etc. In view of their lightness, aluminium and its alloys are sometimes used instead of iron or steel in the manufacture of structural frameworks, ships' superstructures, bridges, sliding doors, electric grid or radio pylons, telescopic pit props, door or window frames, railings, etc.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 7610.90.99, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 10% ad valorem; ASEAN-China Free Trade Area (ACFTA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "E"; and Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) Agreement rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of CO Form "RCEP" or Declaration of Origin (DO) issued by an Approved Exporter.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"PULMOMAX"

Based on the Certificate of Product Registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), product leaflet, technical data sheet, certificate of analysis, and manufacturing procedure and flowchart submitted, subject article is a solution for animal drinking water in the form of a yellow liquid. It is composed of eucalyptus oil, peppermint oil, turmeric extract, thyme extract, glycerin, propylene glycol, and water. Packed in 1-L bottles, subject article is added to the drinking water of poultry, swine, and cattle to, among others, help in the proper functioning of respiratory systems and to help liquefy sticky mucus and open breathing passages.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 23.09 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers preparations of a kind used in animal feeding. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers sweetened forage and prepared animal feeding stuffs consisting of a mixture of several nutrients designed, among others, to achieve a suitable daily diet by supplementing the basic farm-produced feed with organic or inorganic substances (supplementary feed). The heading includes products of a kind used in animal feeding, obtained by processing vegetable or animal materials to such an extent that they have lost the essential characteristics of the original material, for example, in the case of products obtained from vegetable materials, those which have been treated to such an extent that the characteristic cellular structure of the original vegetable material is no longer recognizable under a microscope.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 2309.90.20, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of zero.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"CHELAVIT D3"

Based on the Certificate of Product Registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), product leaflet, technical data sheet, assay method of finished products, packaging confirmation, and manufacturing procedure and flowchart submitted, subject article is a vitamin and mineral liquid solution for poultry. It is composed of vitamins D₃ and K₃, zinc glycinate, copper (II) glycinate, manganese glycinate, phosphoric acid, plant extracts and oils, glycerin, propylene glycol, and water. Packed in 1-L bottles, subject article is added to poultry drinking water at a dosage of 100 mL or 200 mL per 1,000 L drinking water, to, among others, maintain mineral homeostasis, regulate the calcium-phosphorous balance, improve tissue mineralization, and support absorption of vitamins in poultry.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 23.09 of the ASEAN Harmonised Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2022 covers preparations of a kind used in animal feeding. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers sweetened forage and prepared animal feeding stuffs consisting of a mixture of several nutrients designed, among others, to achieve a suitable daily diet by supplementing the basic farm-produced feed with organic or inorganic substances (supplementary feed). Farm-produced feed is usually rather low in proteins, minerals or vitamins. The preparations devised to compensate for these deficiencies, so as to ensure a well-balanced animal diet, consist of proteins, minerals or vitamins plus additional-energy feeds (carbohydrates) which serve as a carrier for the other ingredients. Although, qualitatively, these preparations have much the same composition as those described in complete feeds, they are distinguished by a relatively high content of one particular nutrient.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2022 subheading 2309.90.20, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of zero.

This ruling shall be valid for five years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
