WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION

To: The District Commander ESS-CPD, Port of Davao

WHEREAS, on 14 August 2024, Upi Municipal Police Station, together with 1st MP 1st PMFC, MDNPPO, PIU MDNPPO and PSOG MDNPPO conducted a joint checkpoint in front of 1st MP 1st PMFC Detachment at Brgy. Nuro, Upi, Maguindanao Del Norte. During the operation, they were able to flag down two (2) convoy vehicles loaded with smuggled cigarettes which resulted to its seizure. The following goods were seized, to wit:

WHEREAS, on 15 August 2024, the above-seized items were turned over by Police Captain Yasher T. Hadjirulla, Provincial Mobile Force Company, Maguiridanao del Norte, to the Bureau of Customs, Sub-Port of Parang, and received by SAI Monaim Moctar, ESS-CPD Sub-Port of Parang for purpose of disposition to proper authority;

WHEREAS, on 19 August 2024, SAI Monaim B. Moctar, Officer-in-Charge, Sector Commander, Sub-Port of Parang, SP/LT. Mangurun C. Batuampar, Jr., ESS District Commander, Port of Davao and IO-II Felix A. Espino III, Field Station Chief, CIIS Davao, submitted a report relative to the seizure and turn-over of the seized items and recommended for the issuance of Warrant of Seizure and Detention. Such recommendation was concurred to by then Atty. Mohammad M. Ben-Usman, former Sub-Port Collector of Parang;

WHEREAS, on 21 January 2025, Abolkhayr L. Cali, Customs Examiner, conducted an examination of the subject seized items. In his report, he recommended for the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention on the ground that the goods are considered smuggled in violation of Section 117, Section 1113 (a) & (k) and Section 400 of R.A. No. 10863 otherwise known as the "Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA). Such recommendation was concurred to by Pangandaman C. Casan, Chief, Assessment Division and Atty. Vicente V. Yutangco, Jr., Deputy Collector for Assessment;

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested by law in this Office, you are hereby ordered to forthwith SEIZE the aforementioned articles and take into physical possession and, custody thereof. Compliance with Customs Administrative Order No.10-2020, particularly, in the manner of making a return of service is likewise prescribed and the submission of inventory Report on the list of the seized cargo is to be strictly observed.
