In line with the Bureau of Customs' (BOC) commitment to ensuring the accuracy, timeliness, and consistency of information dissemination, all groups, collection districts, divisions, services, offices, and units are hereby directed to designate their respective Information Officers and Action Officers for CY 2025.

The designated **Information Officers** will be responsible for the following:

- 1. Coordination with the Public Information and Assistance Division (PIAD): Coordinate with PIAD on media-related matters, public information campaigns, and the development and dissemination of official BOC statements and communication materials.
- 2. Gathering and Validating Reports: Collect and verify relevant data and reports from their respective Groups, attached units, and offices to support accurate public communication.
- 3. *Timely Submission of Updates*: Facilitate the prompt submission of accurate data, reports, and updates as required by PIAD.

Meanwhile, assigned <u>Action Officers</u> will be tasked with the following responsibilities:

1. Handling Client Concerns: Address and resolve inquiries, complaints, and feedback from clients and stakeholders in a

timely and professional manner, in compliance with ARTAmandated turnaround times.

- 2. Direct Coordination with the Public Information and Assistance Division (PIAD): Ensure timely and efficient communication with CARES to facilitate the resolution of issues and concerns
- 3. Tracking and Reporting: Maintain a record of all client-related concerns and complaints, ensuring proper follow-up and reporting to PIAD.
