Dear Sir/Ma'am,

The Department of Foreign Affairs, through the Intelligence and Security Unit, conveys its thanks and appreciation to your Office for the inputs and efforts during the drafting of the revision of Department Order 3-65 re: Procedures on Processing of Diplomatic Clearance for Aircraft and Vessels.

Herewith, for your consumption, is a signed copy of the <u>Department Order No.</u> <u>2025-001</u> entitled "Procedures, Requirements and Conditions for Diplomatic Clearance of Foreign Aircraft and Vessels" dated 18 March 2025.

The new procedures and requirements shall apply to:

- 1. All foreign state (owned, operated, chartered, and/or military) aircraft and instruments intending to enter, transit, and depart from Philippine airspace including those intending to call at designated airports (landing or staging area) in the territory of the Philippines as part of official, peaceful, and approved activities.
- 2. All foreign state (owned, operated, chartered, and/or military) vessels, including its complement or launch craft, vessels, instruments, and platforms, intending to visit and/or call at designated seaports in the territory of the Philippines as part of official, peaceful and approved activities.
- 3. Clearance requests for aircraft and vessels participating in military exercises, covered by all Status of Forces Agreements (SOFA) and other agreements of a similar nature, shall be processed and issued by the Department of National Defense. A Joint Memorandum Circular shall be issued by the DFA, DND, DOTr and other concerned agencies to effectively implement this arrangement.

The D.O. shall take effect fifteen (15) days from the date of its deposit with the Office of National Administrative Registrar (ONAR), University of the Philippines Law Center, Quezon City.
