WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION

To: ESS-CPD
Sector Commander
Sub-Port of General Santos

WHEREAS, on 09 November 2024, PNP Special Task Group Plutos (STG Plutos), together with GENSAN MARPSTA and RMU 12 conducted an intelligence monitoring and operation at Purok Crisostomo, Purok Lanoy and Purok Quilantang, Brgy Calumpang, General Santos City, which resulted to the seizure of the following, to wit:

WHEREAS, on 11 November 2024, the above-seized articles were turned over by Police Captain Marcelino Antonio A. Nalus, through Pat. James Harold O. Villacarlos, General Santos City Maritime Police Station, and received by SAI Rogel E. Julio, Sector Commander, ESS-CPD, Sub-Port of General Santos, for safekeeping and for purposes of proper disposition;

WHEREAS, on 11 November 2024, Customs Examiner Jovannie D. Prado, submitted a report relative to the conduct of physical examination of the seized items. Customs Examiner Prado issued a certification that the seized goods were considered as smuggled and recommended for the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention in violation of Section 117, Section 1113 and Section 400 of R.A. No. 10863 otherwise known as the "Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA)";

WHEREAS, IA-II Michael D. Cariga, Team Leader, CIIS, Sub-Port of General Santos issued a Certification dated 11 November 2024 that as per records, the claimant is not registered or accredited importer with the Bureau of Customs;

WHEREAS, on 09 December 2024, ESS District Commander SP/Capt. Mangurun C. Batuampar, Jr., and CIIS Chief IO-II Felix A. Espino III, also recommended for the issuance of Warrant of Seizure and Detention;

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested by law in this Office, you are hereby ordered to forthwith SEIZE the aforementioned articles and take physical possession and, custody. Compliance with Customs Administrative Order No.10-2020, particularly, in the manner of making a return of service and the submission of inventory Report on the list of the seized cargo be strictly observed.
