Basman and CIIS representative, IO-I Vanne Ishvi A. Lamoste. Customs Examiner Cali recommended for the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention in violation of Section 117, Section 1113 and Section 400 of R.A. No. 10863 otherwise known as the "Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA)";



WHEREAS, on 18 December 2024, ESS District Commander SP/Capt. Mangurun C. Batuampar, Jr., and CIIS Chief IO-II Felix A. Espino III, recommended for the issuance of Warrant of Seizure and Detention of the above seized items; and

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested by law in this Office, you are hereby ordered to forthwith SEIZE the aforementioned articles and take physical possession and, custody. Compliance with Customs Administrative Order No.10-2020, particularly, in the manner of making a return of service and the submission of inventory Report on the list of the seized cargo be strictly observed.
