**WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION**

WHEREAS, on 06 March 2025, South Cotabato Provincial Highway Patrol Team-RHPU 12, together with Sto. Nino Municipal Police Station and South Cotabato CIDG conducted an anti-carnapping operation and routinary inspection at the National Highway, Brgy. Ambalgan, Sto. Nino, South Cotabato. During the operation, a vehicle carrying smuggled cigarettes was flagged down which resulted to its seizure, to wit:

WHEREAS, on 07 March 2025, the above-seized articles were turned over by PSMS Rey E. Sabornido, from RHPU 12 – South Cotabato Provincial, HPT, and received by SAI Rogel E. Julio, Sector Commander, ESS-CPD, Sub-Port of General Santos, for safekeeping and for purposes of proper disposition;

WHEREAS, on 07 March 2025, Customs Examiner Jovannie D. Prado, submitted a report relative to the conduct of physical examination of the seized items. Customs Examiner Prado issued a certification that the seized goods were considered as smuggled and recommended for the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention in violation of Section 117, Section 1113 and Section 400 of R.A. No. 10863 otherwise known as the "Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA)";

WHEREAS, IA-II Michael D. Cariga, Team Leader, CIIS, Sub-Port of General Santos issued a Certification dated 07 March 2025 that as per records, the claimant is not registered or accredited importer with the Bureau of Customs;

WHEREAS, on 20 March 2025, ESS District Commander SP/LT. Mangurun C. Batuampar, Jr., and CIIS Chief IO-II Felix A. Espino III, also recommended for the issuance of Warrant of Seizure; and

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested by law in this Office, you are hereby ordered to forthwith SEIZE the aforementioned articles and take physical possession and custody. In compliance with Customs Administrative Order No.10-2020, particularly, in the manner of making a return of service and the submission of Inventory Report on the list of the seized cargo be strictly observed.
