**WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION**

To: ESS-CPD  
Sector Commander  
Sub-Port of General Santos

WHEREAS, on 04 March 2025, General Santos City Highway Patrol Group (HPG) conducted an anti-carnapping operation along Maharlika Highway, Brgy Apopong, General Santos City. During the operation, a motorcycle was flagged down due to initial violation of improvised plate that led to the discovery of smuggled cigarettes inside the motorcycle which resulted its seizure, to wit:

WHEREAS, on 04 March 2025, the above-seized articles were turned over by PMSG Mark Anthony Austria, Highway Patrol Group, General Santos City, and received by SAI Rogel E. Julio, Sector Commander, ESS-CPD, Sub-Port of General Santos, for safekeeping and for purposes of proper disposition;

WHEREAS, on 04 March 2025, Customs Examiner Vivian A. Jimenez, submitted a report relative to the conduct of physical examination of the seized items. Customs Examiner Prado issued a certification that the seized goods were considered as smuggled and recommended for the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention in violation of Section 117, Section 1113 and Section 400 of R.A. No. 10863 otherwise known as the "Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA)";

WHEREAS, IA-II Michael D. Cariga, Team Leader, CIIS, Sub-Port of General Santos issued a Certification dated 05 March 2025 that as per records, the claimant is not registered or accredited importer with the Bureau of Customs;

WHEREAS, on 21 March 2025, ESS District Commander SP/Capt. Mangurun C. Batuampar, Jr., and CIIS Chief IO-II Felix A. Espino III, also recommended for the issuance of Warrant of Seizure; and

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested by law in this Office, you are hereby ordered to forthwith SEIZE the aforementioned articles and take physical possession and, custody. In compliance with Customs Administrative Order No.10-2020, particularly, in the manner of making a return of service and the submission of Inventory Report on the list of the seized cargo be strictly observed.
