## WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION

To: The District Commander ESS-CPD, Port of Davao

WHEREAS, a shipment of 1X40' said to contain one (1) Mercedez Benz GLE350 VIN WDCED2EB5JA095998 and one (1) unit BMW M5 2014 VIN WBSFV9109FD095277 consigned to HEUNGSU GIM on board of a vessel SITC Qiuming V.2411N with Bill of Lading No. SITINDT075662G arrived on 12 September 2024, at the Port of Davao;

WHEREAS, on 11 February 2025, Kevin Carl D. Dida, Acting Field Officer, XIP, SP/CAPT. Mangurun C. Batuampar, Jr., District Commander, ESS and IO-II Felix A. Espino III, Chief, CIIS Field Station, requested for a Spot Check of the above-mentioned shipment for possible violations of CMTA and other laws, rules and regulations:

WHEREAS, on 16 April 2025, Amer-Hassan G. Mangoyag, Customs Examiner, submitted a report relative to the conduct of physical examination of the subject shipment last 15 April 2025. The shipment was found to be USED (1) Mercedez Benz GLE350 VIN WDCED2EB5JA095998 and one (1) unit BMW M5 2014 VIN WBSFV9109FD095277. Such examination was witnessed by CIIS, ESS and XIP representatives, CCBI representatives, Aljun Lozano and Diosdado Cubelo;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 156, "Providing for a Comprehensive Industrial Policy and Directions for the Motor Vehicle Development Program and its Implementing Guidelines", Section 3.1 specifically provides that, "The importation into the country, inclusive of the Freeport, of all types of used motor vehicles is prohibited, except those allowed by law. The subject vehicles do not belong to the list of exempted importation.

WHEREAS, Section 5.1 of Executive Order 156, also states that, "All imported vehicles found to be in violation of any provision in this EO shall be subject to seizure without redemption by the Bureau of Customs":

WHEREAS, Section 4.1 of CAO 10-2020 in relation to Section 1113 of the CMTA, "Properties Subject to Seizure & Forfeiture". Properties which are imported or exported under the following circumstances shall be subject to seizure and forfeiture: (b) Goods the importation or exportation is effected or attempted contrary to law and (c) Goods of prohibited importation or exportation.



WHEREAS, Customs Examiner Mangoyag with the concurrence of Pangandaman C. Casan Chief, Assessment Division and Atty. Vicente V. Yutangco, Jr., Deputy Collector for Assessment recommended for the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention against the ENTIRE SHIPMENT, in violation of Executive Order No. 156, "Providing for a Comprehensive Industrial Policy and Directions for the Motor Vehicle Development Program and its Implementing Guidelines" in relation to Section 4.1 of CAO 10-2020, Section 1113 (f) (I-4) "Properties Subject to Seizure & Forfeiture".

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested by law in this Office, you are hereby ordered to forthwith SEIZE the afore-mentioned articles and take physical possession and custody. In compliance with Customs Administrative Order No.10-2020, particularly, in the manner of making a return of service and the submission of Inventory Report on the list of the seized cargo be strictly observed.
