In case of goods kindly indicate the brand being offered in your price quotation form (Annex "A") Submission of quotation and eligibility documents is on or before May 13, 2025, 10:00 a.m., at General Services Division (GSD), Ground Floor, OCOM Building, Port Area, Manila.

Award of contract shall be made to the lowest quotation, which complies with the minimum description as stated above and other terms and conditions stated in the price quotation form.
