DECREE OF ABANDONMENT

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2025, a shipment of 1 pkg. lcl pp ball arrived at the Manila International Container Port covered by Bill of Lading No. CSEH12500154, **ALMEX TECHNOLOGIES PHILIPPINES INC.**, Consignee.

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2025, consignee filed a request for express abandonment thru portal under ticket number LAWDIV75689421. Attached to the portal is letter submitted by Danielyn Burabod, Supply & Procurement Department, Assistant Manager, Almex Technologies Philippines Inc.

"We ALMEX TECHNOLOGIES PHILIPPINES INC., is the ultimate shipper of the item PP BALL.

YUE CHEN TECHNOLOGY (CHENGDU) CO LTD. our shipper erroneously shipped the goods to PH port which that intended to Nagoya, Japan. With this, we voluntarily abandon the ownership and/or any rights over the cargo. We agree that the BOC PH may dispose of the cargo in any manner they choose.xxx"

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2025, an Affidavit of Express Abandonment was executed by Danielyn Burabod, reiterating to wit:

4. The corporation filed the said request for express abandonment because of the shipper erroneously shipped the goods to Philippines port which that intended to Nagoya, Japan. With this we voluntarily abandon the ownership and/or any rights over the cargo. We agree that the BOC PH may dispose of the cargo in any manner they choose."



WHEREAS, in support of the request of herein consignee, attached are the following documents: Bill of Lading No. CSEH12500154, General Information Sheet (GIS), Secretary's Certificate and Government IDs.

WHEREAS, Section 1129 of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA) provides:

**"Section 1129. Abandonment, kinds and Effects of: -
Imported goods are deemed abandoned under any of the
following circumstances:**

***(a) When the owner, importer, or consignee of the
imported goods expressly signifies in writing to the
District Collector the intention to abandon the
same;***

WHEREFORE, premises considered, it is hereby ordered and decreed that the above-described shipment be, as it is hereby ordered abandoned in favor of the government pursuant to Section 1129 of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA), subject to clearance by the Legal Service of this Bureau prior to actual turn over to the Auction and Cargo Disposal Division, (ACDD), this Port, for custody and safekeeping pending the final disposition thereof in the manner provided for by law.

Let copies of this Notice and Declaration of Abandonment be furnished to all parties and offices concerned.
