**WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION**

To: The District Commander  
ESS-CPD, Port of Davao

WHEREAS, on 26 December 2024, personnel of City Special Operations Group (lead Unit) led by P/LT Mark Ferd A. Barte conducted a monitoring of illegal activities in Purok 4, Isla Verde, barangay 23-C, Davao City which resulted to the apprehension of Abdul Bassar Asarab Mohammad **who** voluntarily surrendered 20 master cases of the following smuggled cigarettes, to wit:

WHEREAS, on 27 December 2024, the above-seized articles were turned-over by PSSG Ryan B. Selerio and received by SA1 Georich P. Llamera, ESS-CPD representative, Port of Davao; and witnessed by IO1 Vanne Ishvi A. Lamoste, CIIS-Davao for safekeeping and for purposes of proper disposition;

WHEREAS, on 17 February 2025, an examination was conducted by COO III Gil D. Generalao, Jr., who submitted a report relative to the conduct of physical examination of the seized items in the presence of SA1 Georich P. Llamera, ESS-CPD representative, Port of Davao and IO1 Vanne Ishvi A. Lamoste, CIIS-Davao.

WHEREAS, on 11 April 2025, ESS District Commander SP/CAPT. Mangurun C. Batuampar, Jr., and CIIS Chief IO-II Felix A. Espino III, recommended for the issuance of Warrant of Seizure and Detention of the above seized items.

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested by law in this Office, you are hereby ordered to forthwith SEIZE the aforementioned articles and take physical possession and, custody. In compliance with Customs Administrative Order No.10-2020, particularly, in the manner of making a return of service and the submission of Inventory Report on the list of the seized cargo be strictly observed.
