WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION

To: ESS-CPD

Sub-Port of Parang

WHEREAS, on 02 February 2025, Buluan Municipal Police Station, 3rd MP, 2nd MDSPMFC conducted a routine mobile patrol operation. During the operation, they discovered various abandoned smuggled cigarettes at Quiapo St. Brgy. Poblacion, Buluan, Maguindanao del Sur which resulted to its seizure, to wit:

WHEREAS, on 03 February 2025, the above seized cigarettes were turned over by PSSG Johari D. Adzid, from PNP Buluan Municipal Police Station, and received by SAI Sadam T. Marbia, ESS-CPD, Sub-Port of Parang, for safekeeping and for purposes of proper disposition;

WHEREAS, on 13 February 2025, SAI Monaim B. Moctar, Officer-in-Charge, Sector Commander, Sub-Port of Parang, SP/Capt. Mangurun C. Batuampar, Jr., ESS District Commander, Port of Davao and IO-II Felix A. Espino III, Field Station Chief, CIIS Davao, submitted a report relative to the seizure and turn-over of the seized items and recommended for the issuance of Warrant of Seizure and Detention. Such recommendation was concurred to by COO-V Mark Ian C. Quinones, Acting Sub-Port Collector, Sub-Port of Parang;

WHEREAS, on 08 May 2025, Customs Examiner Abolkhayr L. Cali, submitted a report relative to the conduct of physical examination of the seized items in the presence of SAI Sadam T. Marbia, ESS-CPD, Sub-Port of Parang. Customs Examiner Cali recommended for the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention in violation of Section 117, Section 1113 and Section 400 of R.A. No. 10863 otherwise known as the "Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA)". Such recommendation was concurred to by Pangandaman C. Casan, Acting Chief, Assessment Division and Atty. Vicente V. Yutangco, Jr., Deputy Collector for Assessment Division; and

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested by law in this Office, you are hereby ordered to forthwith SEIZE the aforementioned articles and take physical possession and, custody. In compliance with Customs Administrative Order No.10-2020, particularly, in the manner of making a return of service and the submission of Inventory Report on the list of the seized cargo be strictly observed.
