**WHEREAS**, a Parcel with Tracking No. CR905461114DE stc: Produc: XSales Good, arrived at  
Surface Mail Exchange Department (SMED) on 26 June 2025, from Junior Koeila of Gerncsheime 4I 4OUG  
Dusseldorf,

**WHEREAS**, on even date, the assigned customs examiner together with PhilPost – SMED, XIP,  
CIIS, CAIDTF and PDEA representatives conducted physical examination of the subject parcel and was  
found to actually contain one (1) transparent plastic pouch containing more or less five hundred three (503)  
pieces of off-white colored tablets with broken pieces;

**WHEREAS**, upon confirmatory test conducted by PDEA on even date, the sample specimen were  
positive for the presence of 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA), as evidenced by Chemistry  
Report No. PDEA-NCR-25-0269 issued by Atty. Severino P. Uy, Jr., RCh, Chief, Examination Division;

**WHEREAS**, in a Memorandum dated 04 July 2025, Gerard Patrick G. Manansala, COO III, Section  
6, Formal Entry Division, Duty Examiner / Customs Postal Office, recommended the issuance of a Warrant  
of Seizure and Detention (WSD) against the subject parcel pursuant to Section 119(d) of the Customs  
Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA);

**WHEREAS**, in a Memorandum bearing the same date, SP/LT. Allan C. Escueta, Team Leader,  
Customs Anti- Illegal Drug Task Force (CAIDTF), Port of Manila submitted photographs of the subject parcel;

**WHEREAS**, the foregoing circumstances show the existence of probable cause for the issuance of  
a WSD pursuant to Sections 118 and 119(d) of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA), in relation  
to Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9165 otherwise known as the "Comprehensive Dangerous Drug Act of 2002";

Failure to do so, the Warrant shall ipso facto be considered null and void.**
